1.4 Uses & Restrictions

- Identified Uses: Plasticizer, industrial solvent, cosmetic fragrance fixative, laboratory reagent.
- Uses Advised Against: Food contact, medicinal purposes, unventilated enclosed space use.

SECTION 3: Composition/Information on Ingredients

- Substance / Mixture: Pure substance
- Active Component: Diethyl Phthalate (CAS 84-66-2)
- Concentration: $\geq 99.0\%$
- Impurities: $\leq 1.0\%$ (Water, phthalic acid monoethyl ester)

SECTION 4: First Aid Measures

- Inhaled: Move to fresh air; give oxygen if needed; seek medical attention.
- Skin Contact: Rinse with running water for 15 minutes; remove contaminated clothing.
- Eye Contact: Rinse with plenty of water for 15 minutes; consult a doctor.
- Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting; rinse mouth with water; seek medical attention.

SECTION 5: Firefighting Measures

- Suitable Extinguishing Media: Dry powder, CO₂, foam, water spray.

- Special Hazards: Vapors are heavier than air; toxic fumes (CO) when burned.

- Personal Precautions: Evacuate non-essential personnel; wear full PPE; eliminate ignition sources.
- Environmental Precautions: Prevent entry into drains/watercourses.
- Clean-Up Methods: Small spills: Absorb with inert materials; large spills: Contain and transfer to sealed containers.

- Handling: Operate in well-ventilated areas with explosion-proof equipment; use anti-static tools.
- Storage: Cool, dry, well-ventilated warehouse ($\leq 30^{\circ}\text{C}$); sealed, away from heat/sparks/oxidizers.
- Incompatibilities: Strong oxidizers, acids, bases.
- Shelf Life: 12 months (unopened).

- Engineering Controls: Local exhaust ventilation; explosion-proof equipment.

- PPE: Chemical safety goggles/face shield; nitrile rubber gloves; organic vapor respirator.
- Exposure Limits: TWA (8h): 5 mg/m³ (OSHA).
